Job 10. TCCC booth- Two people to answer questions about the club and our purpose "recruiting" 7-9p.m. two hours

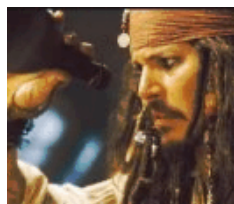
Job 11. Piñata- One person to pull it up and down
